### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The club does not accept liability for any theft, accident, damage, injury or illness, however caused, to horses, owners, riders, spectators or any other person or property.
2. Correct riding dress must be worn whenever mounted, whether competing or not. A correctly fitted and secured hat must be worn when mounted, lungeing, leading or loading horses. Hats must carry one of the following current hat standards: PAS 015 (1998 or 2011) or: VG1 01.040 (1014-12) both with BSI kitemark: ASTM F1163 (2004a, 04a onwards) with SEI mark: SNELL E2001 with official SNELL label & number or AS/NZS 3838 (2006 onwards) with SAI Global mark. At all BRC Area qualifiers & Championships hats must show aqua hat tag.
3. Classes will be judged according to current BD Rules.
4. Entry fees cannot be refunded unless a vet. or doctor's certificate is provided.
5. All dogs must be kept on short leads.
6. **Current Covid 19 restrictions will strictly apply. QR code on the gate to be scanned on arrival. Only one person allowed to accompany the rider. Please park at least 3 metres apart and leave the showground as soon as possible after competing.**
