- CLASS 1 Nursery.** Open to any height of horse or pony. Ponies (14.2hh & under) and horses (over 14.2hh) will be judged separately

- CLASS 2 Ponies 13.2hh. & under.** Fences approx. 60cm. (2'0)
- CLASS 3 Horses/ponies any height,** never to have won 3 show jumping competitions

- CLASS 4 Novice ponies 14.2hh. & under.** Combination of pony/rider never to have won 3 show jumping competitions.

- CLASS 5 Novice Horses over 14.2hh.** Combination of horse/rider never to have won 3 show jumping competitions at this height

- CLASS 6 Topscore** Fences approx. 75cm. (2'6") Joker 90cm. (3')

- CLASS 7 Riders under 18 years.** Horses/ponies any height. Fences approx. 85cm. (2'9")

- CLASS 13 Best Turned Out.** Riders 18 years and over.
- CLASS 14 Best Turned Out.** Riders under 18 years.
These classes may be amalgamated according to entries.
- CLASS 15 In Hand Thoroughbred Horses** –unregistered with RoR
- CLASS 16 RoR OPEN In Hand Show Series Qualifier (Formerly TARRA)**
Open to all RoR registered horses, 3yrs and over, fillies, mares and geldings. Horses that have raced abroad or been in training are also eligible. Blemishes caused through racing will be ignored. This class is a qualifier for the RoR OPEN In Hand Showing Series FINAL at the RoR National Championship Show at Aintree, August 2018.
The first three horses will qualify.
Rosettes 1st - 6th. Prizes - 1st £30 plus RoR jacket, 2nd £20, 3rd £10, 4th £10
- CLASS 17 In Hand** Skewbald and piebald horse or pony any age or height
- CLASS 18 Young Stock** – any breed. 3 years and under
- CLASS 19 Best Handler** – Senior and Junior
- CLASS 20 In Hand Veteran.** Horse/pony 15 years or over. Special rosette for the oldest veteran.
- CLASS 21 Ridden Thoroughbred Horses** –unregistered with RoR
- CLASS 22 RoR AMATEUR Ridden Show Series Qualifier (Formerly TARRA)**
Open to all RoR and NR registered horses, 4yrs and over, mares and geldings, owned, produced and ridden by an Amateur.
The Series is open to AMATEURS only – those employed in racing will be allowed to compete. Class will be judged under 'riding horse' format without 'type' being taken into consideration. Blemishes caused through racing will be ignored.
The first three horses will qualify.
The Judge will not ride at the qualifier but will ride in the final.
This class is a qualifier for the RoR AMATEUR Ridden Show Series FINAL at the RoR National Championship Show at Aintree, August 2018.
Rosettes 1st - 6th. Prizes - 1st £40 plus RoR jacket, 2nd £30, 3rd £20, 4th £10
Amateur definition: Any breaches of this ruling will be taken seriously and will result in disqualification from future classes.
An amateur is a person who for the purpose of RoR classes does not/has not during the current season or previous season:
Engage (d) in breeding, livery, buying or selling, dealing or hiring horses (for the show ring) in a commercial capacity.
Horses must not have been stabled at or reside in a Professional Producer's/Trainer's yard (in the current season or previous season).
Riders must not have ridden any animals produced by a Professional/Trainer in the current or previous season.
Horses and riders must not have received any help from a Professional Producer/Trainer at a SHOW in the current or previous season.

Horses must not have been ridden at a show by a rider who has ridden for a Professional/Producer Trainer in the current or previous season.

CLASS 23 Ridden Skewbald/Piebald Horse/pony any type or height.

CLASS 24 Ridden Veteran. Horse/pony 15 years or over.

CLASS 25 Riding Club Horse over 14.2hh. May be required to jump a small fence

CLASS 26 Riding Club Pony, 14.2hh & under. May be required to jump a small fence

CLASS 27 Family Mount. To be suitable for all family members. May be required to jump a small fence and/or another obedience test at the Judge's discretion.

The Paul Brackley Challenge Cup will be awarded to the Senior WRC member (18 years & over) gaining the most points at this show on one horse or pony

The Mavis Whitehead Memorial Challenge Trophy will be awarded to the Junior WRC Member (under 18 years) gaining the highest total of points at this show on one horse or pony

The Punters' Anonymous Challenge Cup will be awarded to the combination of the senior WRC member on the same horse who gains the most points at the open shows in April, June and September.

The Broadgate Hector Trophy will be awarded to the combination of the junior WRC member on the same horse gaining the most points at open shows in April, June & September

The KCSnax Trophy will be awarded to the WRC member (Senior or Junior) gaining the most points in the Riders 18 years and over and Riders Under 18 years classes in the Open Shows in April, June and September.

WRC Members placed 1st-6th will be awarded points from 6 – 1 in each class to be accumulated towards the Senior and Junior Club Trophies at the end of the season.

NOTE. **RoR Riding Club Challenge.** RoR registered horses can gain points in classes at this show in both rings. Horses placed 1st-6th will be awarded points from 6-1 in addition to 1 point for each class entered but not placed.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. A correctly fitted and secured hat must be worn when mounted, lungeing, leading or loading horses. Hats must carry one of the following current hat standards: PAS 015 (1998 or 2011) or: VG1 01.040 (2014-12) both with BSI kitemark: ASTM F1163 (2004a, 04a onwards) with SEI mark: SNELL E2001 & 2016 with official SNELL label & number or AS/NZS 3838 (2006 onwards) with SAI Global mark. At all BRC Area qualifiers & Championships hats must show BRC aqua hat tag.
2. Body protectors are recommended
3. Correct riding dress must be worn at all times when mounted (no chaps or half-chaps). Any competitor will be eliminated if a lost hat is not replaced during a competition.
4. Whips may not exceed 30".
5. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry and does not accept liability for any theft, accident, damage, injury or illness, however caused to horses, owners, riders, spectators, or any other person or property
6. Entry fees cannot be refunded unless a Vet. or Doctor's certificate is provided.
7. The judge's decision in all matters is to be accepted as final.
8. Show Jumping classes will be judged under B.S.J.A. rules. After a fall a rider must leave the ring immediately without further jumping.
9. Horses and ponies must be 4 years and over.
10. All horses/ponies will be required to assemble in the collecting ring 10 minutes before the time of the class.
11. Any competitor galloping in the exercise area will be asked to withdraw from the show.
12. All dogs must be kept on leads.
13. **Each competitor is required to pay £2.00 for the First Aid service.**

Rosettes will be awarded to sixth place
