- CLASS 1 Nursery.** Open to any height of horse or pony. Ponies (14.2hh & under) and horses (over 14.2hh) will be judged separately. Fences approx. 55 cm. (1'9")
- CLASS 2 Ponies 13.2hh. & under.** Fences approx. 60 cm. (2'0")
- CLASS 3 Horses/ponies any height,** never to have won 3 show jumping competitions Fences approx. 70 cm. (2'3")
- CLASS 4 Novice ponies 14.2hh. & under.** Combination of pony/rider never to have won 3 show jumping competitions. Fences approx. 75 cm. (2'6")
- CLASS 5 Novice Horses over 14.2hh.** Combination of horse/rider never to have won 3 show jumping competitions at this height Fences approx. 75 cm. (2'6")
- CLASS 6 Riders under 18 years.** Horses/ponies any height. Fences approx. 85 cm. (2'9")

- CLASS 7 Riders 18 years and over.** Fences approx. 85 cm. (2'9")

- CLASS 9 Intermediate. Horses over 14.2hh.** Fences approx. 90 cm. (3')

- CLASS 11 Small Open. Horses over 14.2hh.** Fences approx. 1 m. (3'3")

The Punters' Anonymous Challenge Cup will be awarded to the combination of the senior WRC member on the same horse who gains the most points at the Spring, Summer and Autumn open shows

The Broadgate Hector Trophy will be awarded to the combination of the junior WRC member on the same horse gaining the most points at the Spring, Summer & Autumn open shows

The KCSnax Trophy will be awarded to the WRC member (Senior or Junior) gaining the most points in the Riders 18 years and over and Riders Under 18 years classes at the Spring, Summer and Autumn open shows.

WRC Members placed 1st-6th will be awarded points from 6 – 1 in each class to be accumulated towards the Senior and Junior Club Trophies at the end of the season.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. A correctly fitted and secured hat must be worn when mounted, lungeing, leading or loading horses. Hats must carry one of the following current hat standards: PAS 015 (1998 or 2011) with BSI kitemark: VG1 01.040 (2014-12) with BSI kitemark: ASTM F1163 (2004a, 04a onwards) with SEI mark: SNELL E2001 & 2016 with official SNELL label & number or AS/NZS 3838 (2006 onwards) with SAI Global mark. At all BRC Area qualifiers & Championships hats must show BRC acqua hat tag.
2. Body protectors are recommended.
3. Correct riding dress must be worn at all times when mounted, whether competing or not, and any competitor will be eliminated if a lost hat is not replaced during a competition.
4. Whips may not exceed 75cm.(30").
5. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry and does not accept liability for any theft, accident, damage, injury or illness, however caused, to horses, owners, riders, spectators, or any other person or property
6. Entry fees cannot be refunded unless a Vet. or Doctor's certificate is produced.
7. The judge's decision in all matters is to be accepted as final.
8. Show Jumping classes will be judged according to B.S.J.A. rules.
9. Horses and ponies must be 4 years and over except where stated otherwise
10. All horses/ponies will be required to assemble in the collecting ring 10 minutes before the time of the class.
11. Any competitor galloping in the exercise area will be asked to withdraw from the show.
12. All dogs must be kept on leads
13. **Each competitor is required to pay £2.00 for the First Aid service**
