CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- A correctly fitted and secured hat must be worn when mounted, lungeing, leading or loading horses. Hats must carry one of the following current hat standards: PAS 015 (1998 or 2011) or: VG1 01.040 (2014-12) both with BSI kitemark: ASTM F1163 (2004a, 04a onwards) with SEI mark: SNELL E2001& 2016 with official SNELL label & number or AS/NZS 3838 (2006 onwards) with SAI Global mark. At all BRC Area qualifiers & Championships hats must show agua hat tag.
- 2. Body protectors are recommended.
- 3. Correct riding dress must be worn at all times when mounted, whether competing or not, and any competitor will be eliminated if a lost hat is not replaced during a competition. Jackets must be worn when competing.
- 4. Whips may not exceed 75cm.(30").
- 5. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry and does not accept liability for any theft, accident, damage,
- 6. injury or illness, however caused to horse, owners, riders, spectators, or any other person or property
- 7. Entry fees cannot be refunded unless a Vet. or Doctor's certificate is produced.
- 8. The judge's decision in all matters is to be accepted as final.
- 9. Show Jumping classes will be judged under B.S. rules.
- 10. Horses and ponies must be 4 years and over.
- 11. All horses/ponies will be required to assemble in the collecting ring 10 minutes before the time of the class.
- 12. Any competitor galloping in the exercise area will be asked to withdraw from the show.
- 13. All dogs must be kept on leads
- 14. Each competitor is required to pay £2.00 for the First Aid service
