- CLASS 1** **Nursery.** Open to any height of horse or pony. Rosettes 1<sup>st</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> for ponies 14.2hh & under, and for horses over 14.2hh. *Kindly sponsored by ABC Saddlery Ltd.* Fences 1<sup>st</sup> round approx 55cm (1'9"). Jump-off approx. 60cm (2'0").
- CLASS 2** **Ponies 13.2hh. and under** Magic Perpetual Challenge Shield Fences approx. 60cm. (2'0")  
*Kindly sponsored by Newmarket Racehorse Transport Ltd*
- CLASS 3** **Horses/Ponies any height..** Combination of horse and rider never to have won three show jumping competitions. Ali's Delight Memorial Challenge Shield. *Kindly sponsored by Mr. Jim Hiner* Fences approx. 70cm.(2'3")
- CLASS 4** **Roaring Forties.** For Riders over 40 years. 1<sup>st</sup> Prize £15, 2<sup>nd</sup> - £12, 3<sup>rd</sup> - £9 and Challenge Cup. (*Kindly sponsored by Mr. & Mrs. R. Millar*) Fences approx. 75cm. (2'6")
- CLASS 5** **Novice. Ponies 14.2hh. and under.** Combination of pony and rider never to have won three show jumping competitions. *Kindly sponsored by Helen Edwards Clinics Ltd.* Claygate Tango Challenge Trophy Fences approx. 75cm. (2'6")
- CLASS 6** **Novice Horse over 14.2hh.** Jeff Barlow Challenge Trophy Fences approx. 75cm.(2'6")

Horses that have raced abroad or been in training are also eligible. Blemishes caused through racing will be ignored. This class is a qualifier for the RoR OPEN In Hand Showing Series FINAL at the RoR National Championship Show at Aintree, August 2018. The first three horses will qualify. Vouchers for Rosettes 1<sup>st</sup> - 6<sup>th</sup>. and Prizes - 1<sup>st</sup> £30 plus RoR jacket, 2<sup>nd</sup> £20, 3<sup>rd</sup> £10, 4<sup>th</sup> £10
- Class 18** Coloured – any height (Palamino, Spotted, Appalusian, Paints, Skewbald, Piebald – Odd colours)  
*(Kindly sponsored by Dale Powell – Farrier)*
- Class 19** In Hand Veteran – 15 years & over (*Fleece rug – kindly sponsored by S. Middleton*)
- Class 20** In Hand Mountain & Moorland - any age, any height – All Welsh sections, Highland, Fell, Connemara, Shetland and Dartmoor. (£15, £7 and £3 – *Kindly sponsored by Mr. & Mrs. Rick Kirby*)
- Class 21** **In Hand Championship** for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> placed in In Hand classes

**Ridden classes** (will not start before 1pm.) – Judge will not ride

- Class 22** B.T.O Riders 18 years and over (El Dajani Challenge Trophy)
- Class 23** B.T.O. Riders under 18 years (Mark Rose Challenge Plate)
- Class 24** Novice – any breed – not to have won three showing classes (*Sponsored by Forelock and Load*)
- Class 25** Sports Horse (Saddle Pad – sponsored by Gibsons Saddlers Ltd)
- Class 26** **RoR AMATEUR Ridden Show Series Qualifier ( Formerly TARRA)** Open to all RoR and NR registered horses, 4yrs and over, mares and geldings, owned, produced and ridden by an Amateur. The Series is open to AMATEURS only – those employed in racing will be allowed to compete. Class will be judged under 'riding horse' format without 'type' being taken into consideration. Blemishes caused through racing will be ignored The first three horses will qualify. The Judge will not ride at the qualifier but will ride in the final. This class is a qualifier for the RoR AMATEUR Ridden Show Series FINAL at the RoR National Championship Show at Aintree, August 2018.  
**Rosettes 1st - 6th. Vouchers for Prizes - 1st £40 plus RoR jacket, 2nd £30, 3rd £20, 4th £10** Amateur definition: Any breaches of this ruling will be taken seriously and will result in disqualification from future classes. An amateur is a person who for the purpose of RoR classes does not/has not during the current season or previous season: Engage (d) in breeding, livery, buying or selling, dealing or hiring horses (for the show ring) in a commercial capacity. Horses must not have been stabled at or reside in a Professional Producer's/Trainer's yard (in the current season or previous season). Riders must not have ridden any animals produced by a Professional/Trainer in the current or previous season. Horses and riders must not have received any help from a Professional Producer/Trainer at a SHOW in the current or previous season. Horses must not have been ridden at a show by a rider who has ridden for a Professional/Producer Trainer in the current or previous season.
- Class 27** Coloureds (as classified in Class 18) *Kindly sponsored by Forelock and Load Ltd*
- Class 28** Veteran – 15 years and over (Montego Bay Memorial Trophy) (Voucher for photo-shoot and large print of horse & rider-  
*(Kindly sponsored by H. Kaye-Watts)*)
- Class 29** Mountain & Moorland (as classified in Class 20) £35, £10, £5 – (*kindly sponsored by Wayne Tanner*)
- Class 30** **Ridden Championships** – (Sash and rug – *kindly sponsored by Rebecca Lowe – farrier*)

**The Heaven Sent Memorial Challenge Cup** will be awarded to the senior WRC member gaining the highest total of points at this show on one horse.

**The Skittles Memorial Challenge Trophy** will be awarded to the junior WRC member gaining the highest total of points at this show on one horse.

**The Punters' Anonymous Challenge Cup** will be awarded to the combination of the senior WRC member on the same horse who gains the most points at the Spring, Summer & Autumn shows.

**The Broadgate Hector Trophy** will be awarded to the combination of the junior WRC member on the same horse who gains the most points at the Spring, Summer and Autumn open shows

**The KCSnax Trophy** will be awarded to the WRC member (Senior or Junior) gaining the most points in the Riders 18 years and over and Riders Under 18 years classes in the Spring, Summer and Autumn open shows..

**WRC Members** placed 1<sup>st</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> will be awarded points from 6 – 1 in each class to be accumulated towards the Senior and Junior Club Trophies at the end of the season.

**NOTE. RoR Riding Club Challenge.** RoR registered horses can gain points in classes at this show in both rings. Horses placed 1<sup>st</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> will be awarded points from 6-1 in addition to 1 point for each class entered but not placed.

#### **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

1. A correctly fitted and secured hat must be worn when mounted, lungeing, leading or loading horses. Hats must carry one of the following current hat standards: PAS 015 (1998 or 2011) or: VG1 01.040 (2014-12) both with BSI kitemark: ASTM F1163 (2004a, 04a onwards) with SEI mark: SNELL E2001& 2016 with official SNELL label & number or AS/NZS 3838 (2006 onwards) with SAI Global mark. At all BRC Area qualifiers & Championships hats must show BRC aqua hat tag.
2. Body protectors are recommended
3. Correct riding dress must be worn at all times when mounted (no chaps or half-chaps). Any competitor will be eliminated if a lost hat is not replaced during a competition.
4. Whips may not exceed 30".
5. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry and does not accept liability for any theft, accident, damage, injury or illness, however caused to horses, owners, riders, spectators, or any other person or property
6. Entry fees cannot be refunded unless a Vet. or Doctor's certificate is provided.
7. The judge's decision in all matters is to be accepted as final.
8. Show Jumping classes will be judged under B.S. rules. After a fall a rider must leave the ring immediately without further jumping.
9. Horses and ponies must be 4 years and over.
10. All horses/ponies will be required to assemble in the collecting ring 10 minutes before the time of the class.
11. Any competitor galloping in the exercise area will be asked to withdraw from the show.
12. All dogs must be kept on leads.
13. Each competitor is required to pay £2.00 for the First Aid service.
