- CLASS 3 – Preliminary 2 (2024)**
- CLASS 4 – Preliminary 3 (2024)**
- CLASS 5 – Preliminary 3 (2024) and Show jumps at approx. 60cm (2'0")**
- CLASS 6 – Novice 2 (2024)**
- CLASS 7 – Novice 3 (2024)**
- CLASS 8 – Novice 3 (2024) and Show jumps at approx. 75cm (2'6")**
- CLASS 9 – Pick a Test – Elementary 1 (2024) or Medium 1 (2024)**

**CLASS 11 – Assisted Starter – 1 'helper' may be in the ring to assist, lead reins permitted
Fences approx. 40cm (1'6")**

CLASS 12 – Starter Fences approx. 40cm (1'6")

**CLASS 13 – Assisted Nursery - 1 'helper' may be in the ring to assist but must not jump the fences, lead reins
not permitted Fences approx. 50cm (1'8")**

CLASS 14 – Nursery Fences approx. 50cm (1'8")

**CLASS 15 – Assisted Small Novice - 1 'helper' may be in the ring to assist but must not jump the fences, lead
reins not permitted Fences approx. 60cm (2'0")**

CLASS 16 – Small Novice Fences approx. 60cm (2'0")

Classes 17-20 will be run as table A7 (jump-off against the clock for all that jump a clear first round)

Not before 12.30pm

CLASS 17 – Novice Fences approx. 70cm (2'4")

CLASS 18 – Intermediate Fences approx. 75cm (2'6")

CLASS 19 – Small Open Fences approx. 85cm (2'9")

CLASS 20 – Open Fences approx. 90cm (3'0")

British Riding Clubs Club Jumping Series

The aim of this series is to create an accessible and inclusive SJ series for BRC members who currently **do not take part in area competitions** or may be nervous about competing, who have disabilities which prevents them from jumping higher or those that are new to BRC and maybe have never jumped before. Clubs will run relevant classes at their club shows for riders to gain qualification to take part at the finals on 6 September 2025 at Bury Farm Equestrian Centre, Leighton Buzzard where there will be three sections in each height class – 11 and under, 12 – 18 and 19 and over (age of 1 January) if sufficient entries. Combinations must not have competed at a BRC Championship with a jumping element in the previous 3 years and not competed at a height greater than 15cm more than the qualifying class in the previous 12 months. Riders can compete at no more than 2 consecutive heights at the finals. Spurs are not permitted. Riders must be club members and qualify by gaining 2 clear rounds at the relevant height (lead reins not permitted). Qualification cards, which cost £11 may be purchased for the combination retrospectively within 3 weeks of the competition and before the end of the qualification period of 18 August 2025 using our published results as evidence at <https://brc.org.uk/select>. CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Our shows are run according to British Riding Club rules.
2. **Please be aware of rule changes for 2025 especially around the use of whips in the arena and practice areas.**
3. A correctly fitted and secured hat must be worn when mounted, lunging or loading horses. Hats must carry one of the following current hat standards: PAS 015; 2011 with BSI kitemark, VG1 with BSI kitemark, SNELL 2016 onwards with official SNELL label & number ASTM F1163; 2004a onwards with SEI mark or AS/NZS 3838; 2006 onwards.
4. Correct riding dress must be worn at all times when mounted, whether competing or not, and any competitor will be eliminated if a lost hat is not replaced during a competition. Body protectors are recommended.
5. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry and does not accept liability for any theft, accident, damage, injury or illness, however caused, to horses, owners, riders, spectators, vehicles or any other person or property.
6. Entry fees cannot be refunded unless a Vet. or Doctor's certificate is produced.
7. The judge's decision in all matters is to be accepted as final.
8. Horses and ponies must be 3 years or over for Dressage and 4 years or over for Combined Training and Show jumping
9. Any competitor galloping in the exercise area or unruly animals may be asked to withdraw from the show.
10. All dogs must be kept on short leads.
11. No mucking out of horse boxes on the showground.
12. Please use bins provided for rubbish.
