Open to members and non-members. All competitors and grooms must adhere to VHS Rules in all circumstances. Failure to do so may result in immediate disqualification. *Those wishing to join or renew the Society will need to apply for this before 1 April each year or a late penalty fee of £15 will be charged.*

VHS Regional Final qualification. All competitors placed 1st to 4th in each Area Qualifier class will qualify for the corresponding class at VHS Regional Finals. Members must carry their card in the ring at all times and have their showing card signed by the judge as proof of qualification. Non-members will receive a red qualification card which can be exchanged for signed showing card when applying for VHS membership, this MUST be done within 21 days of qualification. It is the competitor's responsibility to present their Showing card to the judge.

Regional Finals are open to members only.

All competitors are eligible to enter open classes at the National Veteran Championships, 29-31 August 2025 at Arena UK, Grantham Lincolnshire. No qualification or membership necessary. See VHS website for schedule which is available mid-season in 2025.

The Rescue Equine Showing Society qualifer

This Show is affiliated to The Rescue Equine Showing Society final taking place at the Equifest, Arena UK, Grantham, Lincolnshire on 1-4 August 2025. The two highest exhibits not already qualified in each affiliated class will qualify.

Open to any age, type, breed. Mares with foal at foot are not permitted. No exhibit under the age of one year may be exhibited on its own.

DEFINITION OF RESCUE:

1. Any equine that is adopted, fostered, under a guardianship scheme from any National Equine Welfare Council registered Charity (NEWC).
2. Any equine that has been adopted, fostered, under a guardianship scheme from any other equine charity (must be registered with the Charity Commission).
3. Any equine that has been 'independently' rescued by an individual. There must be supporting evidence (photographic, veterinary) that will be included in the 'Rescue History' for the equine, to demonstrate their rescue status.

(*) This show is a qualifier for The Sunshine Tour Championships held at the All-England Showground, Hickstead from Thursday 11 to Sunday 14 September. The Championships are for unaffiliated and amateur competitors in Dressage from Intro to Elementary, Show Jumping from lead rein to 1.05m; Showing for lead rein, in-hand, ridden, veterans plus many more.

Qualification: Dressage and Show Jumping: 1st-3rd place, Showing: 1st-4th place.

Qualification does not pass down the line.

Registration must be completed within one month of qualification (sooner for late July shows). Restrictions apply to horse and competitor's previous winnings and amateur status.

WRC will do its best to post all show results on their website within 7 days of a show to enable use as evidence.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Our shows are run according to British Riding Club rules.
2. Please be aware of rule changes for 2025 especially around the use of whips in the show jumping arena and practice areas.
3. Our shows are intended to be family friendly novice shows and the judge's decision in all matters is to be accepted as final.
4. A correctly fitted and secured hat must be worn when mounted, lunging or loading horses. Hats must carry one of the following current hat standards: PAS 015; 2011 with BSI kitemark, VG1 with BSI kitemark, SNELL 2016 onwards with official SNELL label & number ASTM F1163; 2004a onwards with SEI mark or AS/NZS 3838; 2006 onwards.
5. Correct riding dress must be worn at all times when mounted, whether competing or not, and any competitor will be eliminated if a lost hat is not replaced during a competition. Body protectors are recommended.
6. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry and does not accept liability for any theft, accident, damage, injury or illness, however caused, to horses, owners, riders, spectators, vehicles or any other person or property.
7. Entry fees cannot be refunded unless a Vet. or Doctor's certificate is produced.
8. The judge's decision in all matters is to be accepted as final.
9. Ridden horses and ponies must be 3 years or over. Any horse or pony jumping must be 4 years or over.
10. Any competitor galloping in the exercise area or unruly animals may be asked to withdraw from the show.
11. All dogs must be kept on short leads.
12. No mucking out of horse boxes on the showground.
13. Please use bins provided for rubbish.
