Passports will need to be taken to the secretary's shed before unloading to show every horse/pony has had at least 2 primary influenza vaccinations or an annual booster within the last 12 months.

Also, animals cannot compete if they have had a vaccination within the last 6 days.

If you have a valid WRC vaccine pass from a previous event we do not need to see your passport again as long as you still have the pass to show the ring steward and your vaccination is still current.

Entry fees for all classes except Working Hunter and clear round jumping are:

Non-members £12 (£16 after 10 July); WRC members £7 (£11 after 10 July)

Working Hunter: Non-members £17 (£21 after 29 May); WRC members £12 (£16 after 29 May)

Clear round: Non-members £7; WRC members £4 per round (combination may enter more than once)

Entries taken on the day (except RoR classes)

Cash, bank transfer or cheques accepted (unable to take card payments)

Entries for the RoR classes must be made in advance and by 6 July at the very latest as WRC have to confirm eligibility to enter with RoR.

To compete as a club member membership must have been completed in the past 12 months prior to entry at <https://britishridingclubs.sport80.com>

Each competitor must pay an additional £3 to cover First-aid provision.

Open to all RoR and NR competition registered horses, Mare or gelding 4yrs old, any height. Riders must be 15 years or over on 1 January 2026. Horses to be ridden in any suitable bridle and should be plaited. All entries must have current RoR Competition Registered. Racing injuries and blemishes ARE IGNORED in this series. **The first three go forward to the final at The Jockey Club RoR National Championships at Aintree, 22 August 2026**

Prizes: RoR rosettes 1st-4th plus RoR official merchandise voucher 1st £20, 2nd £10, 3rd £5, Highest placed Veteran (15+) £10 plus rosette.

The Highest Placed Veteran also qualifies for the Tattersalls RoR Ridden Veteran Show final at the Jockey Club RoR National Championships on 22 August 2026.

The Judge will NOT ride. Horses may be stripped for conformation at the discretion of the judge. **Competitors must wear a safety/kite-mark hard hat with a chinstrap.** All those entering and/or participating in RoR classes agree to be bound by the Retraining of Racehorses Rules and Regulations from time to time in force. The class to be judged **50% jumping, 20% style while jumping and performance, and 30% awarded** for show, manners and suitability to be retrained.

PHASE 1 – Jumping to be judged: 8 rustic jumps 70cm to 80cm with a maximum spread of 75cm. The following points to be deducted at the end of each jumping round: 10 points to be deducted for a knock down, 15 points to be deducted for a refusal, 20 points for second refusal. Elimination for third refusal or fall or Error of Course.

PHASE 2 – Class returns without boots and judged for an individual show/conformation. *(In some classes, at the judge's discretion, horses might be asked to do a 'show' following their jumping without leaving the ring. This is often the case with a large number in the class.)*

Each horse to complete an individual show of no longer than 1½ minutes. Show to include the following movements: walk, trot, canter showing change of leg, extended canter (gallop) halt and stand, walk off on long rein. Total marks out of **30%** for show, manners and suitability to be retrained. Fences for the final at Aintree can be up to a maximum of 85cm with a spread of 80cm.

Open to all RoR and NR **competition registered** horses, 3years and over, fillies, mares and geldings. Handlers must be 15 years or over on 1 January 2026. Horses do not need to be shod to compete in the RoR Open In-Hand class. Horses can be shown in a Bitless/In-Hand Bridle. Blemishes caused through racing will be ignored. All RoR members entering horses and/or participating in the show agree to be bound by the Retraining of Racehorses Rules and Regulations from time to time in force. Handlers/grooms must wear a current safety/kite mark hard hat with a chinstrap.

All entrants to RoR classes must have current RoR competition membership, which is £15 per year and can be obtained online at <https://www.ror.org.uk/registration>.

Open to all RoR and NR competition registered horses, 4 years and over, mares and geldings, owned, produced and ridden by an **Amateur**. Riders must be 15 years or over on 1 January 2026. Horses should be ridden in a snaffle, Pelham or simple double bridle with a plain cavesson noseband. Horses should be plaited. Racing injuries and blemishes ARE IGNORED in this series. The Series is open to AMATEUR riders only – those employed in racing will be allowed to compete. Class will be judged under 'riding horse' format without 'type' being taken into consideration. The Judge will not ride in the qualifiers but will ride in the Final. Competitors/grooms must wear a safety/kitemark hard hat with a chinstrap.

Amateur definition: The rules are as in the rulebook with the following addition that an amateur may not show a horse owned or sponsored by a company or commercial firm. In addition, a person classed as amateur must not be supported by a company in any way or act as brand ambassador whether financially or in-kind. An amateur is a person who for the purpose of RoR classes does not/has not during the current season or previous season:

Engage(d) in breeding, livery, buying or selling, dealing or hiring horses in a commercial capacity: Horses must not have been stabled at or reside in a Professional Producer's/Trainer's yard from 1 January 2025. Riders must not have ridden any animals produced by a Professional/Trainer in the current or previous season. Horses and riders must not receive any help from a Professional Producer/Trainer at a SHOW in the current season. A rider who has ridden for a Professional/Producer Trainer in the current or previous season must not have ridden horses at a show. Any breaches of this ruling will be taken seriously and will result in disqualification from future classes.

Highest placed Veteran (15+) £10 plus rosette.

The first three go forward to the final at the Hickstead Derby Meeting June 2027

The winner also qualifies for the Tattersalls RoR Amateur Ridden Special at the Jockey Club RoR National Championships on 23 August 2026. Highest Placed Veteran qualifies for the RoR Ridden Veteran Final in August 2027.

Qualification does not pass down the line.

Registration must be completed within one month of qualification (sooner for late July shows). Restrictions apply to horse and competitor's previous winnings and amateur status. **Please check online at www.sunshinetour.co.uk for more information, to register and submit evidence of results.**

WRC will do its best to post all show results on their website within 7 days of a show to enable use as evidence.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Our shows are run according to British Riding Club rules.
2. Our shows are intended to be family friendly novice shows and the judge's decision in all matters is to be accepted as final
3. A correctly fitted and secured hat must be worn when mounted, lunging or loading horses. Hats must carry one of the following current hat standards: PAS 015; 2011 with BSI kitemark, VG1 with BSI kitemark, SNELL 2016 onwards with official SNELL label & number ASTM F1163; 2004a onwards with SEI mark or AS/NZS 3838; 2006 onwards.
4. **A hard hat must be worn by all Juniors when competing including in-hand classes.**
5. Correct riding dress must be worn at all times when mounted, whether competing or not, and any competitor will be eliminated if a lost hat is not replaced during a competition. Body protectors are recommended.
6. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry and does not accept liability for any theft, accident, damage, injury or illness, however caused, to horses, owners, riders, spectators, vehicles or any other person or property.
7. **Entry fees cannot be refunded or transferred to another show unless a Vet's or Doctor's certificate is produced.**
8. Ridden horses and ponies must be 3 years or over. Any horse or pony jumping must be 4 years or over.
9. Any competitor galloping in the exercise area or unruly animals may be asked to withdraw from the show.
10. All dogs must be kept on short leads.
11. No mucking out of horse boxes on the showground.
12. Please use bins provided for rubbish.
