Rosettes to 6th place in each class.

Rosettes also for best placed Worlington Riding Club member in each open class.
Highest placed Senior and Junior of each Championship class to receive a 'Champion rosette', £10 (on the day) and 3 free class entries for next year (voucher given at Riding Club AGM).

CLASS 1 – Introductory B (2009) Walk & Trot – Lead Rein only

CLASS 2 – Introductory C (2016) Walk & Trot – Lead Reins not permitted

CLASS 3 – Preliminary No. 1 (2006)

CLASS 4 WRC Championship – Preliminary No. 12 (2006). For club members that have qualified during 2024 only

CLASS 5 - Preliminary No 12 (2006) and **Show jumps** at approx. **60cm (2'0")**

CLASS 6 – Novice No. 34 (2009)

CLASS 7 WRC Championship – Novice No. 24 (2010). For club members that have qualified during 2024 only

CLASS 8 – Novice No. 24 (2010) and **Show jumps** at approx. **75cm (2'6")**

CLASS 9 - Pick a Test – Elementary No. 42 (2008) or **Medium No. 63** (2002)

CLASS 10 WRC Championship – Pick a Test - Elementary 49 (2009) or **Medium No.63** (2002). For club members that have qualified during 2024 only

Classes 4 and 5 and/or 7 and 8 may be entered but the Dressage test will only be ridden once.
Class 9 may be entered twice with the same horse/ rider combination if you wish to ride both tests.

The jumping for Classes 5 and 8 will take place after the last person has ridden their test in that class and the current class in arena 1 finishes. Fences will be adjusted so you can all jump together as a group and separate to any S/J class.

CLASS 11 Clear Round Jumping – lead reins permitted 10.00am Fences approx. 45cm (1'6")

Rosettes to 6th place in each class.

Rosette for best placed Worlington Riding Club member in each open class.

Winner of each Championship class to receive a 'Champion rosette', £10 (on the day) and 3 free class entries for next year (voucher given at Riding Club AGM).

Classes 12 – 15 will be run as single phase

Not before 10.30am

CLASS 12 - Assisted – 1 'helper' may be in the ring to assist - lead reins permitted Fences approx. 45cm (1'6")

CLASSES 13 - 19 WILL BE SPLIT INTO CHAMPIONSHIP (for members who have qualified by gaining a clear jump-off round at same height during the season) AND OPEN (for non-members and those members that have not qualified for the championship)

CLASS 13 - Starter Fences approx. 45cm (1'6")

CLASS 14 - Nursery Fences approx. 55cm (1'9")

CLASS 15 - Small Novice Fences approx. 60cm (2'0")

Classes 16 - 19 will be run as table A7 (jump-off against the clock for all that jump a clear first round)

CLASS 16 – Novice Fences approx. 70cm (2'3")

CLASS 17 – Intermediate Fences approx. 75cm (2'6")

CLASS 18 – Small Open Fences approx. 85cm (2'9")

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. A correctly fitted and secured hat must be worn when mounted, lunging or loading horses. Hats must carry one of the following current hat standards: PAS 015; 2011 with BSI kitemark, VG1 with BSI kitemark, SNELL 2016 onwards with official SNELL label & number ASTM F1163; 2004a onwards with SEI mark or AS/NZS 3838; 2006 onwards.
2. Correct riding dress must be worn at all times when mounted, whether competing or not, and any competitor will be eliminated if a lost hat is not replaced during a competition. Body protectors are recommended.
3. Whips must not exceed 75cm (30").
4. Our shows are intended to be family friendly novice shows and the judge's decision in all matters is to be accepted as final
5. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.
6. The Committee does not accept liability for any theft, accident, damage, injury or illness, however caused, to horses, owners, riders, spectators, vehicles or any other person or property while on the showground.
7. Entry fees cannot be refunded unless a Vet. or Doctor's certificate is produced.
8. Show Jumping classes will be judged according to B.S. rules.
9. Ridden horses and ponies must be 3 years or over. Any horse or pony jumping must be 4 years or over.
10. Any competitor galloping in the exercise area or unruly animals may be asked to withdraw from the show.
11. All dogs must be kept on short leads.
12. No mucking out of horse boxes on the showground please.
13. Please use bins provided for rubbish.
