CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. A correctly fitted and secured hat must be worn when mounted, lunging or loading horses. Hats must carry one of the following current hat standards: PAS 015; 2011 with BSI kitemark, VG1 with BSI kitemark, SNELL 2016 onwards with official SNELL label & number ASTM F1163; 2004a onwards with SEI mark or AS/NZS 3838; 2006 onwards.
2. Correct riding dress must be worn at all times when mounted, whether competing or not, and any competitor will be eliminated if a lost hat is not replaced during a competition. Body protectors are recommended.
3. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry and does not accept liability for any theft, accident, damage, injury or illness, however caused, to horses, owners, riders, spectators, vehicles or any other person or property.
4. Entry fees cannot be refunded unless a Vet. or Doctor's certificate is produced.
5. The judge's decision in all matters is to be accepted as final.
6. Classes will be judged according to BD and BSJA rules.
7. Horses and ponies must be 3 years or over for Dressage and 4 years or over for Combined Training and Show jumping
8. Any competitor galloping in the exercise area or unruly animals may be asked to withdraw from the show.
9. All dogs must be kept on short leads.
10. No mucking out of horse boxes on the showground.
11. Please use bins provided for rubbish.
